Bismillah Al-ladhi Laa Ilaaha Illaa Huwa Al-Rahman Al-Raheem, Allah huma Adhib Anni Al-Hamma Wa Al-huzn. Meaning;

In the name of Allah there is none worthy of worship but He, The Most Gracious The Most Merciful, O? Allah, free me of worry and depression.
