Reciting durud shareef upon Rasulullah (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam) has great reward. Saying "Ya Rasulullah" without the belief that Rasulullah (Sallallahu Alayhi Waallam) is "Haazir and Naazir" is permissible. However, if this practice exceeds its limits then it will not be permitted to do so. It is permissible when greeting Rasulullah (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam) to say "As Salaamu Alayka Ya Rasulullah" when visiting his blessed *qabr* in Madinah Munawwarah.
