?Narrated Abu Omamah (radiAllahu anhu): that Allah's Messenger (salallahu alayhiwasalam) was asked, O Messenger of Allah, which supplication is heard (by Allah (Subhanahu wa Ta'ala), he said the end of the night and at the end of the obligatory Salat (prayer) [at-Tirmidhi] This time is after saying 'At-tahyat', and before making Tasleem (finishing prayer)?
