Question 2408) - What are the causes of disinheritance?

- A: There are four:
- 1. Slavery
- 2. Murder
- 3. If the deceased and the heir are of different religions.
- 4. If one party lives in Darul Islaam and the other in Darul Harb,

An Apostate and a slave thus do not inherit from anyone. A murderer Can not inherit from his victim. A Muslim cannot inherit from a Kafir, Kafir cannot inherit from a Muslim. A Harbi cannot inherit from a Zimmi, a Zimmi cannot inherit from a Harbi. Two Harbis cannot inherit from each other if they are in different Dars.
