Did Rasullullah Sallallahu Alaihi Wa Sallam act according to his own will or by Allah Ta'ala's will?

Did Rasullullah Sallallahu Alaihi Wa Sallam act according to his own will or by Allah Ta'ala's will?
"Nor does he speak from (his own) desire. It is not but a revelation revealed (to him). (Najm 3-4)
This verse refers to the speech of Rasullullah Sallallahu Alaihi Wa Sallam. However, it is more general and includes even the conduct of Rasullullah Sallallahu Alaihi Wa Sallam. A Hadith on the authority of Sa'd Ibn Hish'm Radiallahu Ta'ala Anhu states:
"I asked, O Mother of all believers, relate to me the characteristics of Rasullullah Sallallahu Alaihi Wa Sallam. She replied, "Haven't you read the Quran? Verily the characteristics of Rasullullah Sallallahu Alaihi Wa Sallam is the Quran." (Sunan Abi Dawood 2/40)

If Rasullullah Sallallahu Alaihi Wa Sallam made *ljtihad* on any issue which was incorrect, it would immediately be rectified through a revelation so that the error does not persist. There are examples of this in the Quran. If his *ljtihad* was correct, then no *Wahy* would be revealed to amend it indicating the acceptance of his *ljtihad*.
