Question 1893) - Explain the kinds of skull wounds.

- A: There are ten kinds:
- 1. Hasiroh [scratching the skin without bleeding]
- 2. Dami'ah [blood emerges but does not flow]
- 3. Damiyah [blood flows]
- 4. Badi'ah [the skin is cut]
- 5. Mutatohimah [the flesh is penetrated]
- 6. Simhaq [the periosteum or skin between the flesh and bone is Penetrated]
- 7. Muwaddihah [the bone is exposed]
- 8. Hashimah [the bone is broken]
- 9. Munaqqilah [the bone moves after being broken]
- 10. Ammah [penetrates to the brain]
