1) It is permissible to say "Oh messenger of Allah be merciful". The mercy which one asks from Nabi SAW is different from the mercy which one asks from Allah Ta'ala. It is also permissible to say "bestow us with a look of favour".

3) Nabi SAW is physically alive. However, His life is different to this worldly life in that He is not in need of food, drink etc. As for the incidents in your query, then these are all *karamat's* (miracles) which were granted to some chosen slaves of Allah Ta'ala.
