

Question 657) - A man enters Makkah or the Haram several times without Ihram. What is the ruling?

A: If he enters Makkah or the Haram without Ihram then for every entry he must make a Hajj or ,umrah [which now becomes Qada]. If in the same year he enters rhram for the Hajj or a vowed Hajj or Qada or vowed 'Umrah or eada or Sunnah ,Umrah or Mustahab 'Umrah; that will suffice him for his Qada of entry whether he made intention or the eada or not. rf he does that in the next year then he must make intention.
