Question 2347) - Which attire is permissible and which are prohibited for men and women?

A: There are details to this question:

- 1. Neither a man nor a woman may imitate the Kuffar in clothing, apparel and appearance. Men may not imitate women and women may not imitate men.*
- 2. Extravagance and waste are not allowed.
- 3. Men may not wear silk. Women may.
- 4. Men may wear silk and brocade in war according to imaam Abu Yusuf RAH. and Imaam Muhammed RAH. it is Makruh according to Imaam Abu Hanifah RAH.
- 5. There is no harm in men wearing a silken garment is the lengthwise thread is cotton.
- 6. It is Haram for men to wear their loin-cloths, trousers, shirts etc to below the ankles.*
- * Ibn ?Abbas RADI. narrates that Rasulullaah (S.A.W.) said, "May Allah curse the men who imitate women and women who imitate men." [al-Bukhari]
- * Abu Hurayrah RADI. narrates that Rasulullaah (S.A.W.) said, "That which falls below the ankles of the lion-cloth is in Jahannum (Hell)." [al-Bukhari]
