Question 2413) - Who is entitled to two-thirds?
A: Two or more daughters if the decased does not have a son. Also, two or more daughters of a son if the deceased has no direct children or son's son. Also two sisters if they have the same parents as the decased or at least the same father, and the decased has no child, male or female. The father is also entitled to two-thirds if the deceased leaves behind both parents, but no son or daughter.
