2. Umra is not a substitute for farz Hajj. Every effort must be made to perform farz Hajj. This is easy and possible as visas have also been given to repeats (people who performed Hajj previously). This is possible only if there are no first timers for Hajj.
To perform Umra is also an act of great virtue and encouraged. One should perform Umra as much as possible. The performance of Umra should not be reserved only when one cannot

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
