

The Appointed Imaam has the First Right to Lead the Taraaweesh salaah

Q: Salaah-481: I am the Imaam of a Masjid and have made the condition before being appointed that I shall lead the Taraaweesh salaah. The trustees now wish to appoint another Haafidh to lead the Taraaweesh salaah in my presence. Is this correct? Who has the first right to leading the Taraaweesh salaah?

Answer: The Imaam has the first right. Another person may be appointed to lead the Taraaweesh salaah only if the Imaam is incapable of doing so or if he permits it.

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
